Early detection can make a difference.

Why is early detection important?

The Galleri test can increase your chance of finding a signal associated with cancer early, when used in addition to single cancer screenings. The Galleri test looks for a signal associated with active cancer and does not predict your future genetic risk for cancer.



Only 5 recommended cancer screening tests exist today ²: breast, colorectal, lung (for those at risk), cervical, and prostate

Who is eligible?

The Galleri Test is available as a covered benefit to eligible members and their covered dependents that meet the following criteria:




- 50+ years of age
- 40-49 with elevated risk factors
- Covered on an Allegiance member Medical Plan

While individuals ages 40-49 with certain risk factors may be at an elevated risk for cancer, Galleri was only studied in population age 50 and older.

What is the Galleri test?

Galleri is a multi-cancer early detection (MCED) test that looks for a cancer signal across more than 50 types of cancer. It's a screening test, which means that while it does not diagnose cancer, it can improve your chance of finding it early.
